As you may have seen, CDC has this evening issued a new eviction moratorium order. See <https://go.usa.gov/xF5yV>. I can assure that you that we were unaware of any plans to issue this order when we filed the parties' joint motion for an extension to file a scheduling order and discovery plan yesterday.

In light of the new order, we wanted to reach out to see whether plaintiffs intend to file an amended complaint and, if so, whether plaintiffs would agree to defer defendants' current August 6 deadline to respond to the original complaint, so that we would be responding to the amended, operative complaint.
