ORDER

Considering the Plaintiffs Motion for an Administrative Stay of Regulation and to Shorten Time to Respond, any response thereto and the entire record herein

IT IS ORDERED that the Motion is hereby GRANTED.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the effective date of the *Electronic Reporting for Federally Permitted Charter Vessels and Headboats in Gulf of Mexico Fisheries*, 86 Fed. Reg. 60,374 (November 2, 2021) (the “VMS Requirement”) currently scheduled for March 1, 2022 is hereby stayed until further order of this court, and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Defendants and their agents are enjoined from enforcing the VMS Requirement against any member of the Plaintiffs Class until further order of this Court, and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Defendants time to respond to the Plaintiffs Motion for stay is reduced to 7 days to be filed no later than February 9, 2022.
